## **County Officials Up-date December 2013**

Can we ask that all officials submit AREs to us even if you submit (2c & 3) to a higher level, as it helps us to keep track of who is actively officiating, at whatever level and helps to keep the lines of communication open. At the recent England Athletics Annual Officials Forum for County Officials Secretaries one of the big items that came up in discussion was Communication, hence the reason for this update.

**SPORTSHALL COMPETITIONS.** Following discussions with other County Secretaries and Portfolio holders can any official who officiates in any capacity at Sportshall competitions please record them in your T&F ARE as days of competition attended. They, however, cannot be used as evidence for obtaining L2a Club or for up-grading to a higher level 2b County, 2c Regional.

Also congratulations to Chris Cohen who has satisfied the IAAF criteria and is an ITO for another 4 years.
