Annual Record of Athletics Experience. (ARE)

So far this year 21 T&F Officials and 6 Endurance Officials have submitted ARE'S to the respective County Officials Secretary and a very heartfelt thank-you to them for doing so. It may seem to be just another bit of bureaucracy to you and more bits of paper to fill in but for us the County Secretaries they are actually an invaluable aid for us to help us keep up with who is actively officiating in the County at what level of meeting etc. If you are an active official and at any level including 2C & 3 and have not submitted your ARE to the County Secretary please would you do so as soon as possible as next years' availability list will be coming out soon and we would hate to offend you by not having your name in our Address' books!

County Technology.

At the last Derbyshire Athletics Committee meeting held in November a proposal was put forward to purchase, operate and maintain Technology Equipment. Initially this is to be a Photo-finish system followed at a later date by an EDM apparatus. This equipment will have to be obtained by the County in association with interested clubs who will be 'Partners' in the equipment. So far Amber Valley & Erewash AC and Derby AC have expressed an interest and some financial support for the scheme. Some applications for grant funding from various sources have been prepared and submitted. The Total cost for a PF system is currently estimated at around £17k. This equipment will be available for hire as well as for County / Participating clubs use. One proviso for hiring is that it must be applied for in writing and an authorised person is available to accompany / set up and oversee the use of the equipment.
